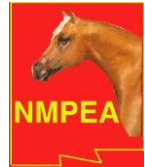

REMINDERS:

- You can join PHBA and NMPEA at a PHBA sanctioned show
- PHBA horses (Palomino & Palomino Bred) can be registered at a PHBA sanctioned show with completed application, photos, and appropriate fees.
- PHBA youth exhibitors DO NOT have to own the horse to exhibit in PHBA classes. The youth and the owner must be paid members of PHBA.
- To be eligible for NMPEA year-end awards, the horse and/or horse and rider team (for youth and amateur) must be nominated and appropriate fees paid. Enrollments start at \$5.00.

NMPEA YEAR-END AWARDS PROGRAM:

Enroll your horse in the NMPEA year-end awards program before your first show and start earning points towards year-end awards! Points can be earned in PHBA approved classes (palomino and palomino bred) and **up to six non-sanctioned shows held in NM (such as Quarter Horse Shows, Hunter/Jumper Events, 4-H Shows, All-Breed Shows and**



more). Only points from shows held in NM can count towards the NMPEA year-end awards; but horses, exhibitors and owners need not reside in NM. Check your PHBA membership card to make sure your NM affiliate membership is current (NMPEA affiliate memberships are available if you live outside NM). Complete rules can be found on the website and a summary is listed on the

enclosed enrollment form. NMPEA also awards a participation award at our year end banquet. Each entry in a PHBA approved class offered in NM enters NMPEA members in a drawing for the participation award.

NMPEA Year-End Awards Program Enrollment Checklist (enrollment form enclosed)

- Completed enrollment form (can be downloaded online from menu on home page of website, www.nmpea.com)
- \$5.00 enrollment fee per horse (for open) or per horse/exhibitor (for amateur or youth)
- Copy(ies) of current PHBA membership card(s) for exhibitor(s) and owner(s)
- Copy of horse's PHBA registration papers

Show Report Card Checklist (report card available online)

- Mail or email report card (or acceptable substitute) to point keeper no more than 30 days after the end of show or event (or by November 15th if show is October 15th or later).
- Copy of show premium (class list)

- NMPEA-Youth were honored for 50 years.
 - The NMPEA Scrapbook won Best Scrapbook for clubs with less than 100 members.
 - The Wayne Justus signed and framed print won by Berniece Zielke at the NMPEA banquet was donated to PHBA



for the live auction at the convention. The winning bid of \$250 was placed by PHBA judge, Howard Rea of Kentucky.

- 2016 Hall of Fame Inductee was Nautical, also known by his PHBA registered name Peter de

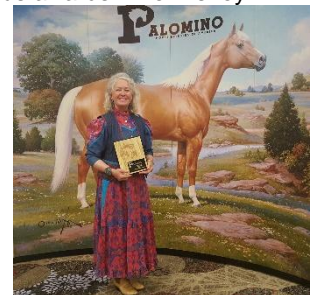


Oro. The 1944 palomino gelding was bred by Mrs. Howard Babcock, Jr. of Roswell and originally trained by Suzanne Norton Jones of Tatum, Nautical qualified for the 1960 Olympics and won the King George V Gold



Cup among other numerous awards. The Disney movie, The Horse with the Flying Tail, was based on his life. Deborah Jones, Suzanne's daughter, accepted the award.

- Votes were cast on approximately 30 proposed rule changes. Three important Rule Changes for 2016 & 2017 are listed below:
 - NEW Amateur Walk/Trot Program effective January 1, 2016. Rules are in the 2016 PHBA Rule Book
 - In 2017, horses will be able to exhibit in Western Pleasure and Ranch Riding at same show;
 - No changes were made to registration rules.
- The NEW PHBA Quarterly Newsletter was unveiled. All PHBA members (one newsletter per mailing address) should have received their Summer Newsletter in May.



Check out the PHBA **Palomino Performance Program** at www.palominohba.com! In addition to recording PHBA points on your horse's permanent show record, your accomplishments in the show arena at shows that are NOT PHBA sanctioned can be recorded on your horse's permanent PHBA record. Annual enrollment is necessary and show results must be submitted to PHBA. Note: This is a separate program from the NMPEA awards program.

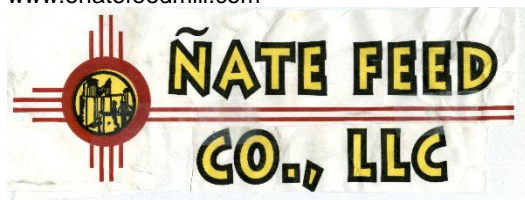

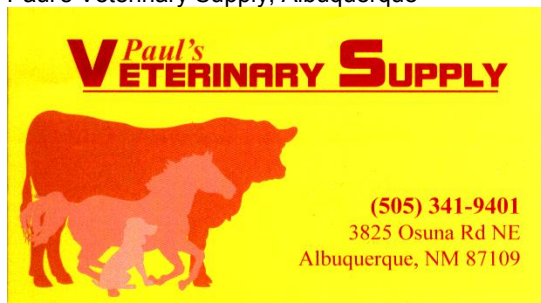
