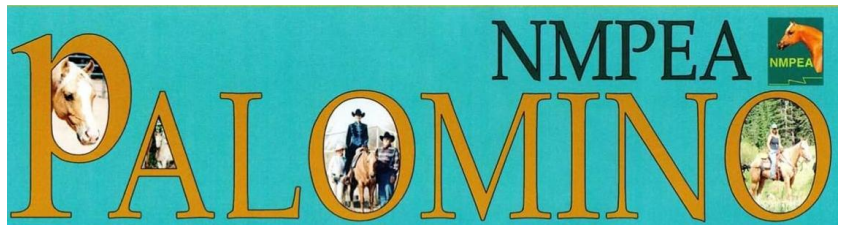


New Mexico Palomino Exhibitor Association – July 2019 Newsletter



2019 SHOW DATES (PHBA Sanctioned Shows):

The Red Chile Fiesta is just around the corner!

Red Chile Fiesta August 17-18, Wright's Rockin Horse Arena, Stanley, NM.

- Triple Judged!
- Palomino, Buckskin, Paint, Pinto and All Breed Classes.
- Be sure to bring copies of your membership cards and registration papers or send with your pre-entries.
- Horses can be registered and memberships paid or renewed at the show. Please make arrangements with Berniece prior to the show at 505-702-2246 if needing to register your horse at the show.
- Show High Points and Reserve High Points will be awarded in all Palomino Divisions: Youth Walk/Trot (both age groups), Novice Youth, Youth (14-18 and 13 & Under), Amateur W/T, Novice Amateur, Amateur and Open; as well as Palomino Bred Divisions Youth, Amateur and Open. High points will receive 25 "points," reserves will receive 15 "points" that can be used to "purchase" awards. Exhibitor can chose Red Chile Palomino logo'd items or combine with "points" from other 2019 shows sponsored by the NM Paint Horse Club and order from their Show Catalog. Almost all awards can be personalized with Palomino logo, event and names. NM Paint Show Awards Catalog can be viewed on the web at www.nmpainthorse.org.
- Youth Entry Fee: \$60 for show (includes all three judges and both days) or \$12/class. Office fee: \$20 if pre-entered, \$30 after 7 pm on Friday, August 16th. Palomino fee per horse \$21. Stalls and tack rooms start at \$25/day or you can show out of your trailer at no charge. **Youth all show entry fee is for one youth/one horse.**
- **FREE cross overs for youth.** Youth can show in any youth classes they are eligible to show in for the one entry fee of \$60 **AND** enter any open classes for **FREE. Must be same youth exhibitor & horse.** Keep in mind that if you have a novice youth card, you can also show in regular youth. If you are showing youth walk/trot, you can only show in walk/trot classes **PLUS** halter & color.
- Amateur & Open Entry Fees: \$120 for show (includes all three judges and both days) or \$22/class. Office fee: \$20 if pre-entered, \$30 after 7 pm on Friday, August 16th. Palomino fee per horse \$21. Stalls and tack rooms start at \$25/day or you can show out of your trailer at no charge. **Amateur all show entry fee is for one amateur/one horse**
- **FREE cross overs for amateurs.** Amateur can show in any amateur classes they are eligible to show in for the one entry fee of \$120 **AND** enter any open classes for **FREE.** Keep in mind that if you have a novice amateur card, you can also show in regular amateur. If you are showing amateur walk/trot, you can only show in walk/trot classes **PLUS** halter & color.

- There are also special discounted fees if you have a horse with papers in multiple breeds. Less than half price to ADD another breed.

- **Cattle reservations (cutting, working cowhorse and boxing) due August 7th and must be pre-paid.**

NM State Fair Palomino Show, September 10-14, Expo NM, Albuquerque, NM, Double Judged. High Point Youth Buckles. Paybacks in classes (open and amateur) with three or more entries. Same dates as Quarter Horse, Paint and Pinto. Double or triple (or more) registered horses can show in multiple breeds. More info can be found online at www.mjmservices.com.

NEW SHOW! FALL COLOR ROUNDUP, October 26-27, Expo NM (NM State Fairgrounds), Albuquerque, NM, Double Judged; Palomino, Buckskin, Paint, Pinto and All Breed Classes. End of season show with some fun classes and breed challenge classes included!

There is a FREE class certificate for NEW NMPEA exhibitors (exhibitor or horse hasn't shown with NMPEA in 2016, 2017 or 2018) that can be downloaded from website, www.nmpea.com. Can be used at Red Chile Fiesta or Fall Color Roundup! Cannot be combined with other coupons.

IT BEARS REPEATING - EXCITING NEWS!

Effective January 1, 2019, the PHBA National Point Scale was revised. National points are now awarded when there are two exhibitors in a class (Palomino or Palomino Bred classes) with the 1st place horse earning one point. The rest of the point schedule remains the same.

NMPEA YEAR END AWARDS PROGRAM: 2019 SHOW SEASON – Nov. 1, 2018 through Oct. 31, 2019 **THERE IS STILL TIME TO ENROLL YOUR HORSE BEFORE YOUR FIRST SHOW!**

Nomination fees for enrollment in NMPEA year end awards program: \$20 enrollment fee per horse allows one horse to be shown by any exhibitor in any division for one fee. Exhibitor(s) and horse owner(s) must be members of PHBA and NMPEA. Points for amateur and youth will be tabulated on one horse and one exhibitor team. Points for open are tabulated on horse (can have multiple exhibitors). Enrollment forms, complete rules and program flyer are available online at www.nmpea.com.

Points from all PHBA sanctioned classes held in NM will count towards NMPEA year end awards and a horse must show in at least one PHBA sanctioned class held in NM to be eligible for year end awards.

AND, up to six non PHBA sanctioned shows held in NM can be SUBMITTED BY AN EXHIBITOR to count towards NMPEA year end awards. Mail or email report card (or acceptable substitute) to point keeper no later than 30 days after the end of a show or event (or by November 15th if show is October 15th or later). 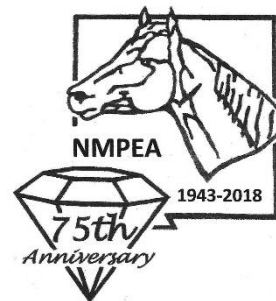
