 Association (NMPEA) was formed in 1943 to
 promote Palomino Horses in the state of New
 Mexico and is the state affiliate (APA) of the
 Palomino Horse Breeders of America (PHBA).
- The Palomino Horse Breeders of America (PHBA), Tulsa, OK, was formed in 1941 as a member owned, non-profit organization for the purpose of registering horses exhibiting a body color of a newly minted US 14k gold coin and having a white mane & tail.
- Palomino horses can be registered with many different organizations such as the American Quarter Horse, Paint Horse, Arabian, Tennessee Walking Horse and many others, provided the horse meets the color requirements. Palomino Bred horses are also eligible for registration provided they have at least one Palomino parent.
- NMPEA hosts horse shows and other events to promote Palomino and Palomino Bred Horses, horsemanship, competition, sportsmanship, family activities and community support.
- In 2020, NMPEA sent a youth judging team to the Arizona National Horse Show in January and adapted to Covid-19 restrictions by hosting a "virtual" horse show.
- From 2016 2019, NMPEA
 - Encouraged exhibitors to show throughout the state and recognized outstanding competitors and first year youth exhibitors at our annual year-end awards banquet
 - Presented awards at the NM State Fair
 4-H Horse Show in Albuquerque & at State 4-H Regional Horse Shows around the state to High Point Palomino exhibitors
 - Provided the NM Horse Council Booth at the NM State Fair with Palomino and Palomino Bred Horses giving fair goers a hands on experience with a horse and provided educational materials about horses to children of all ages
 - Donated over 100 lbs of non-perishable food to Roadrunner Food Bank
